## **Descriptions for Internal and External Categories**

### INTERNAL – School Related Fees

Athletics Fees - School personnel may be able to have Athletic fees waived or reduced.

Club/Co-Curricular - School personnel may be able to have Club/Co-Curricular fees waived or reduced.

AP and ACT Testing - School personnel may be able to have AP – Advanced Placement or ACT fees waived or reduced.

College Applications – School personnel may be able to have college application fees waived or reduced.

Enrichment Classes – Fee based classes and programs offered through the District’s Enrichment Department.

Before and After School Child Care (BASES) – District sponsored tuition-based child care before and after school in the school setting.

Summer Learning Program – School personnel may be able to have tuition fees waived or reduced.

Other – Examples include Senior Breakfast tickets, Senior All Night Party tickets, field trips etc.

### EXTERNAL – Community Based Outreach

Neighborhood House – Emergency Financial and Food Assistance.

Community House – “Community Kitchen” Food support

Rochester Community Schools Foundation – 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization which supports and advances programs and services for Rochester Community Schools students.

Blessings in a Backpack – Weekend food program for students attending Title 1 Rochester Community Schools.

Operation School Bell – Clothing and school supplies provided at no cost to qualifying families.

Other Social Assistance Agencies: Including but not limited to United Way, Crittenton Hospital Medical Center and Oakland Family Services.
